

RASPBERRIES continued

Boyne Raspberry *Rubus idaeus 'Boyne'*

Produces fruit on second year canes. Best planted late winter or early spring. Cold Hardy.

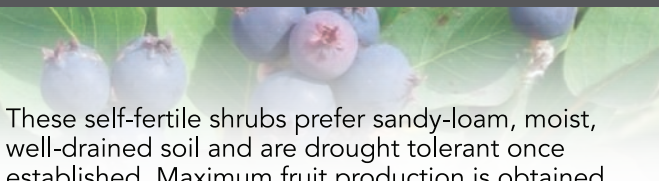
Height : 6.5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Tart/Sweet
Spread : 3-5 ft **Fruit Size :** Medium
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Med-Dark Red
Ripens : Early to Mid Season

Heritage Raspberry *Rubus idaeus 'Heritage'*

Produces on first year new growth. Cut second year canes to ground in fall. Cold Hardy.

Height : 6.5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Tart/Sweet
Spread : 3.5-5 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Bright Red
Ripens : Early Summer to Fall

SASKATOONS



These self-fertile shrubs prefer sandy-loam, moist, well-drained soil and are drought tolerant once established. Maximum fruit production is obtained in full sun. Fruit ripens late June or early July.

Uses : Fresh eating, jams/jellies, baking/desserts, and freezing.

Regent Saskatoon *Amelanchier a. 'Regent'*

Large white blooms with yellow-red fall colour. Compact with few suckers.

Height : 5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Med Sweet
Spread : 5 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Purple-Black

SASKATOONS continued

Thiessen Saskatoon *Amelanchier a. 'Thiessen'*

Leathery green leaves with cream colour blossoms in spring. Hardy, native shrub.

Height : 6 ft **Fruit Taste :** Med Sweet
Spread : 6 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Purple-Black

Smoky Saskatoon *Amelanchier a. 'Smoky'*

Large white blooms in spring, yellow-red fall colour. Highest sugar to acid ratio.

Height : 8 ft **Fruit Taste :** Med Sweet
Spread : 6.5 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Deep Blue

Northline Saskatoon *Amelanchier a. 'Northline'*

Upright with large white blooms in spring, yellow-orange fall colour.

Height : 10 ft **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : 6 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Purple-Blue

Native Saskatoon *Amelanchier alnifolia*

Leathery green leaves with cream colour blossoms in spring. Hardy, native shrub.

Height : 10 ft **Fruit Taste :** Med Sweet
Spread : 6.5 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Purple-Black

Standing Ovation Saskatoon *Amelanchier a. 'Obelisk'*

White blooms in spring, yellow-orange fall colour. Hardy, upright, columnar and compact.

Height : 16 ft **Fruit Taste :** Med Sweet
Spread : 4 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Purple-Blue

BLUEBERRIES



These compact shrubs prefer moist acidic soil and provide better yields with cross pollination.

Uses : Fresh eating, jams/jellies, baking/desserts, and freezing.

Northsky Blueberry *Vaccinium 'Northsky'*

White spring blooms, red fall colour. Hardy cultivar.

Height : 1-2 ft **Fruit Taste :** Wild
Spread : 2-2.5 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Blue
Ripens : Late Season

Northcountry Blueberry *Vaccinium 'Northcountry'*

White blooms in spring, red fall colour.

Height : 2 ft **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : 3.5 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Blue
Ripens : Mid Season

Northblue Blueberry *Vaccinium 'Northblue'*

White blooms in spring, bright red fall colour. Dwarf plant with superior processed flavour.

Height : 2.5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : 3.5 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Dark Blue
Ripens : Mid Season

Chippewa Blueberry *Vaccinium 'Chippewa'*

White spring blooms, red fall colour. Hardy, upright form.

Height : 2.5-3 ft **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : 3 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Blue
Ripens : Mid Summer

BLUEBERRIES continued

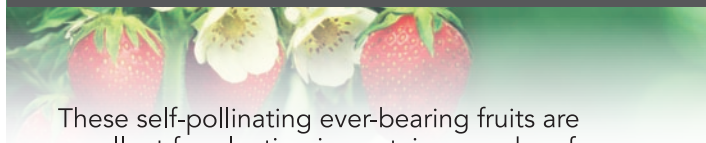
Northland Blueberry *Vaccinium 'Northland'*

Scarlet-red fall colour with a spreading growth habit. Hybrid for sub-zero climates.

Height : 3.5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Wild Berry
Spread : 4 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Dark Blue
Ripens : Mid to Late Season



STRAWBERRIES



These self-pollinating ever-bearing fruits are excellent for planting in containers and prefer moist, well-drained soil.

Uses : Fresh eating, jams/jellies, baking/desserts, freezing, and beauty products.

Tri-Star Strawberry *Fragaria x ananassa 'Tri-Star'*

A heavy producer variety.

Height : 6-8 in **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : Colonies **Fruit Size :** Medium
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Jewel Red
Ripens : Late Spring to Frost

Albion Strawberry *Fragaria x ananassa 'Albion'*

A disease resistant variety.

Height : 12-18 in **Fruit Taste :** Sweet
Spread : 12-18 in **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Deep Red
Ripens : Mid Season to Fall

RASPBERRIES



These self-pollinating shrubs are known for their thorny branches, suckering habit and are often used for naturalization. They prefer well-drained, organically rich soil and produce better quality fruit with 2 or more varieties.

Uses : Fresh eating, jams/jellies, baking/desserts, freezing, herbal & medicinal.

Red River Raspberry *Rubus idaeus 'Red River'*

Produces fruit on first year new growth. Obtains maximum yield when planted in hedge rows.

Height : 2-3 ft **Fruit Taste :** Tart/Sweet
Spread : 2-3 ft **Fruit Size :** Medium
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Red
Ripens : Mid Summer to Frost

Native Raspberry *Rubus idaeus*

White spring blooms, serrated leaflets and arching prickly red canes. Hardy native shrub for reclamation and barriers.

Height : 3.5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Tart
Spread : 1.5-2 ft **Fruit Size :** Small
Zone : 2 **Fruit Colour :** Red
Ripens : Summer

Double Delight Raspberry *Rubus idaeus 'Double Delight'*

Produces fruit on first year new growth. Upright, spreading growth habit.

Height : 3.5-5 ft **Fruit Taste :** Tart/Sweet
Spread : 2-5 ft **Fruit Size :** Large
Zone : 3 **Fruit Colour :** Dark Red
Ripens : Late August to Late September
