INGREDIENTS

coarse chopped pine needles and twigs
distilled white vinegar

DIRECTIONS

1. In a colander, rinse pine needles to wash away any debris.
2. Allow the pine needles to air dry or gently pat down with paper towel.
3. Using a sharp knife, coarsely chop twigs and pine needles to help release the oils & resin.
4. Move the chopped evergreens to a large air tight glass container, such as a mason jar.
5. Pour the white vinegar over the chopped pine needles until covered.
6. Place air tight lid on your container and store in a cool dark place for a minimum of 6 weeks.
7. After a six weeks, strain the mixture through a fine mesh to filter out pine needles and debris.
8. The pine infused vinegar can now be used in place of common household cleaners.

STORAGE

Store in an air tight container in a cool, dry and place.

DIRECTIONS

Bathroom Cleaner

Use full strength to help remove hard water stains when cleaning the bathroom.
Mix with dish soap for a no-scrub shower cleaner.
Use with baking soda for extra scrubbing power when needed.

No Rinse Multi-Purpose Cleaner

Mix 1/2 cup vinegar with 4 cups water and 1/4 tsp dish soap.
Use to clean counter tops, sinks, toilets, and hard floors.
Use mixture for mopping ceramic tile and linoleum floors.

Window Cleaner

Mix 1 cup water with 1 cup vinegar and pour into a spray bottle.
Mist windows and mirrors with the solution and wipe dry.

Stainless Steel Appliance Cleaner

Dampen part of a microfibre cloth with vinegar.
Wipe against the grain of the stainless steel.
Use the dry portion of the cloth to wipe dry.

USE CAUTION

There are a few vinegar don'ts including natural stone, wood, electronics, and grout.
