

Combination Apple

Malus 'Combination'

A multi-grafted tree with typically 3-4 varieties of apples. Self fertile through cross pollination between the grafted varieties. Great for small spaces or in the rural areas if nearby neighbours do not have any apple trees.

TIP : Be careful when pruning. Once a variety is completely pruned off it will not come back.

Please note : The height, spread, and ripening times of a combination apple will vary depending on the varieties grafted and what they are grafted to.

EDIBLE CRABAPPLES

Dolgo Crabapple

Malus 'Dolgo'

A hardy flowering crabapple with an extended flowering time, makes it a great pollinator for other apples. Produces an abundance of crimson coloured crabapples great for eating, cooking and making jellies. Late harvest.

Height : 20 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 13 ft **Ripens :** Late Aug/Sept.

Rescue Crabapple

Malus 'Rescue'

A hardy and productive hybrid apple-crab with green-yellow fruit with red striping. Has a sweet and juicy flavour that is good for eating and cooking.

Height : 20 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 16 ft **Ripens :** Late August

Kerr Crabapple

Malus 'Kerr'

A hardy hybrid apple-crab with tart-sweet red fruit that ripens mid-fall and is good for eating, cooking, and storing. Late harvest.

Height : 18 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** September

Basic Information

Apples Start Producing Fruit at 5-7 years of age.

Apples Need Cross Pollination to produce fruit. Apples need a different apple variety or crabapple within 1 city block for cross pollination to occur. Pears can also work, although not as well.

Eating Apples Have White Flowers. Some crabapples produce edible fruit, flower colour is a good indicator to edibility.

Apple Production Years Will Cycle between high producing years and low producing years.

All Apples Are Grafted onto a hardier root stock.

Growing Tips

Plant With Good Top Soil and organic mix.

Apples Need Good Nutrition to produce fruit. They need to be fertilized or have their soil amended regularly.

Apples Need Good Drainage, do not let roots sit in water. Apples do not tolerate standing water.

Do NOT Cover Roots with grass, fabric or flowers.

Do NOT Let Apples Fruit the First Year. Once a new tree is planted, let it focus its energy on root development for the first year.

Wrap the Trunk in Fall to protect the bark from winter animal damage.

Deer and Moose Can Damage apple trees by eating the buds and tender branches.

Pruning is Important to keep its shape, prevent damage from branches rubbing against each other and to keep the tree a more manageable size for harvesting. Be sure to never prune more than 30% of the tree at one time.

Heyer #12 Apple

Malus 'Heyer #12'

A hardy medium sized yellow apple that ripens early season, harvest fruit when they are slightly under ripe for better storage. Excellent for cooking.

Height : 15 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Late August

Norland Apple

Malus 'Norland'

A hardy early season green apple with red striping and round form. Good for eating, cooking, and storing.

Height : 16 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 16 ft **Ripens :** Late August

Parkland Apple

Malus 'Parkland'

An early season greenish yellow apple with red blush and round form. Good for eating, cooking, and storing.

Height : 16 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 14 ft **Ripens :** Late August

Battleford Apple

Malus 'Battleford'

A mid season, hardy green-yellow apple splashed with red. Has a tart taste, ideal for cooking and storing.

Height : 20 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 16 ft **Ripens :** Mid September

Harcourt Apple

Malus 'Harcourt'

A hardy crisp red apple with a sweet and juicy flavour. Excellent for eating and storing up to 6 months.

Height : 20 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 16 ft **Ripens :** Mid September

Hardi-Mac Apple

Malus 'Hardi-Mac'

A hardy bright red apple with crisp, juicy fruit good for eating and cooking.

Height : 15 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Mid September

September Ruby Apple

Malus 'September Ruby'

A hardy sweet tasting red apple good for eating, cooking, and storing.

Height : 16 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Mid September

Norkent Apple

Malus 'Norkent'

A very hardy juicy green apple with red striping good for eating and cooking.

Height : 15 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Late September

Goodland Apple

Malus 'Goodland'

A late season, high-quality green apple with red blush excellent for eating, cooking, and storing.

Height : 16 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Late September

Fall Red Apple

Malus 'Fall Red'

A hardy dull red apple good for eating, cooking, and storing. Large fruit is good for juicing.

Height : 18 ft **Zone :** 2
Spread : 12 ft **Ripens :** Late September

Honeycrisp Apple

Malus 'Honeycrisp'

A hardy, crisp red apple with a sweet and juicy taste excellent for eating and storing.

Height : 15 ft **Zone :** 3
Spread : 10 ft **Ripens :** Late September
